Cafeteria Reminder

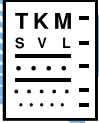

Vision and Hearing Screening At Carney Elementary

All students, including those in self-contained classes, will be screened for vision and hearing problems in grades pre-K, first and fourth by technicians from the Baltimore County Department of Health (BCDH). In addition, kindergarten students NOT screened the previous year in pre-kindergarten will also be screened.

The dates for the screening are : 9/22—9/26. The re-screen date for absentees is 10/10.

All students new to Baltimore County Public School who enter in grades 2, 3, and 5 will be screened as well.

Procedures for the Administration of Medication while in School

*All prescription and non-prescription medications that are needed on a regular basis, including homeopathic medicines, must be accompanied by a written order signed by a physician/nurse practitioner/dentist/physician assistant/osteopath. A signature stamp may be accepted in lieu of a written signature. **Parent's Request to Administer Medication in School** form should be completed by the health care provider and should identify the student, medication, dosage, time frequency, anticipated duration of treatment, side effects, and mode of administration. Medication orders that include all of the above information may also be accepted on health care provider letterhead or prescription blank.*

All prescription medication brought into school should be in a pharmacy labeled bottle. I will not be able to administer any medication without a written physician order. If you have signed the Discretionary Medication form, this will allow your child to receive Tylenol, Tums, cough drops and Benadryl as needed during the school day.
