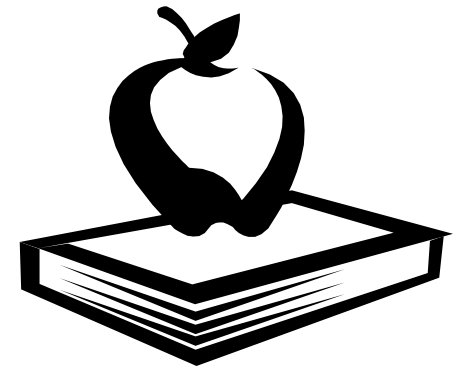

School Responsibilities

High Standards and Expectations: We will...

Communicating: We will...

- ◆ Conduct team and parent/teacher conferences.
- ◆ Provide and collect necessary school information forms.
- ◆ Communicate upcoming events and publish the names of students with exceptional progress via biweekly newsletter.
- ◆ Communicate monthly events via outside sign.
