One of the goals of fifth grade is to prepare students for the organizational demands of middle school. Please provide as many of the following materials and supplies as you can. They will be used to create specific organizational procedures. It may be advisable to keep this list throughout the year, since some of the supplies will need to be replenished. **Please try to have these supplies by the first day of school, as we will begin organizing and labeling materials on that day. \*Please put your child's name on all supplies.\***

Scissors	3 regular size boxes of tissues
1 highlighter	2 red pencils
1 clipboard	Post-its multipak
2 erasable ballpoint pens (blue/black)	Pencil pouch— <b>no school boxes</b>
#2 pencils ( <b>no mechanical pencils</b> )	2 glue sticks—large size
Colored <b>pencils</b>	1 small hand-held manual pencil sharpener
1 box baggies ( <b>gallon size</b> )	1 pack thick washable markers
6 spiral notebooks (2 green, 2 red, 2 blue)	2 5-pack dividers

\*Two-inch binder—**NO ZIPPER BINDERS** (with 2 packs wide-ruled loose-leaf paper)  
12-inch plastic ruler (metric and standard)  
3 duotang pocket folders with fasteners (for library, computer, and homeroom)

The music teacher has requested:

- 1 black #2 pencil with an eraser
- 1 red colored pencil with an eraser
- 1 folder with pockets and 3 metal fasteners (**not a small binder**)
- 5 sheets of plain white, hole-punched paper
- Pencil sharpener with shavings catcher

**\*No trapper keepers, oversized binders or zipper binders!**

**\*All backpacks and lunchboxes need to fit inside lockers!**

**\*No oversized or rolling backpacks, please!**
