

Bridge Center Code of Conduct

Electronics

- All electronic devices and accessories (cell phones, pagers/beepers, MP3 players, IPODS, CD players, headphones, etc..) must be **off and away** during the school day from the opening bell to dismissal as well as while being transported on the bus. **Students are encouraged to leave all electronic devices at home unless absolutely necessary.**
- If this policy is violated, a teacher or staff member will give the student a verbal warning the first time. If subsequent violations occur, the student will hand over the electronic device which will be given to an administrator.
 - Second Offense: Device returned to student at end of the day
 - Third Offense: A parent/guardian/caregiver can pick up the device at the convenience of the administrator.
 - Fourth Offense: Suspension

*As indicated in the BCPS Handbook, the school is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.

Dress

Appropriate clothing for school is essential to supporting an atmosphere conducive to learning. Bridge Center students are expected to show good judgment as well as respect for self and the school in their choice of clothing.

The following guidelines are presented for health and safety reasons:

- Students should not wear skin-tight or see-through clothing.
- Undergarments should not be visible.
- Shorts and skirts must be of appropriate length. The “appropriate length” is beyond finger tips when the student’s arms are extended straight down the side.
- Pajamas and /or slippers may not be worn to school.
- Students should dress in accordance with the season.
- No head covering of any kind (religious or medical excluded).
- Clothing, jewelry, and accessories which depict alcohol, drugs, tobacco, cult-related images, profanity, or symbols related to sex or violence are prohibited.

Remember: Our school is in the business of education, and like any place of business, appropriate dress is expected at all times.

Computers:

- Computers are to be used for educational purposes only. No listening to CDs or downloading music.
- No food or drink near the computers- No Exceptions!

Hallways

- Students must use the CLASS PASS Form in their Planner to travel anywhere in the building.
- Students must have a pass if they aren't in a classroom.
- Students arriving after 7:55 am must have a blue pass from the main office.
- Students that require an early dismissal must present a note from their parent/guardian to the main office to obtain a blue pass.
