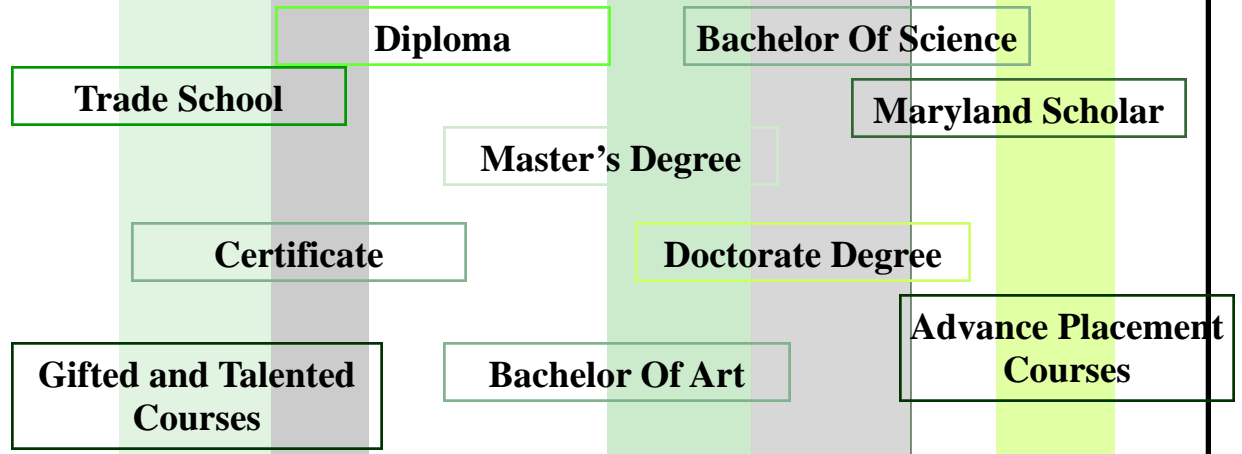
## Academic Goals
